The Hispanic male looked like he was bothering eople were walking away from him as he spoke to them. He told the reporter that he had a April 21, 2016 evening news and saw a news story about a police shooting in Everett told the reporter that he had heard on the news that the police officer told the man to ife.	

wrote he had heard the police officer say "Drop the knife". stated that he actually never heard the police officer say anything, as he was on the MBTA bus when the cruiser pulled up.
