SUBJECT: INTERVIEW OF [REDACTED] AND [REDACTED]

1. On April 21st, 2016, at approximately 2200 hours, Detective Michael Lavey (Everett Police) and I went to 134 Linden St. We were told that, approximately one half hour prior to the officer involved shooting of Mario Mejia-Martinez in Everett Square (Broadway at Norwood and Chelsea St), the Everett Police had received a call for an intoxicated man at this location. Everett Police responded, but could not find the subject and cleared the area.

2. We spoke with [REDACTED], who identified himself as a landlord/caretaker of the apartments at 134 Linden St, and [REDACTED], a resident. They provided the following statement, At 1609 hours, they had been sitting on the front steps of 134 Linden St. They observed a Hispanic male, later identified as Mejia-Martinez, walk into the driveway of the apartment building. [REDACTED] addressed him, but he did not respond. Mejia-Martinez took his backpack off and was mumbling to himself. [REDACTED] did not think he was speaking Spanish and believed his mumbling to be gibberish. Mejia-Martinez sat on a small retaining wall in the driveway and began throwing trash out of the bag and on to the lawn. [REDACTED] yelled to him to "get the fuck outta here!" Mejia-Martinez took out a pint of liquor, chugged the bottle and smashed the glass bottle in the middle of Linden St as he walked away. (Det. Lavey inspected the trash and observed it to be a bottle of vodka). Mejia-Martinez looked back at [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] a few times like he wanted to fight. Mejia-Martinez walked across Linden Street and on to Church St towards Broadway. Mejia-Martinez walked on to the porch of the first home on the right and spoke with a Preacher's wife briefly, but continued down Church St.

3 Trooper Cashman and Det Bobby Hall arrived and spoke with the Preacher's wife Trooper Cashman showed [REDACTED] photographs of Mejia-Martinez that he obtained from his brother. [REDACTED] confirmed that Mejia-Martinez had been the intoxicated man in his driveway during this incident.
