On April 21st, 2016, at approximately 2200 hours, Detective Michael Lavey (Everett Police) and I went to 134 Linden St We were told that, approximately one half hour prior to the officer involved shooting of Mario Mejia-Martinez in Everett Square (Broadway at Norwood and Chelsea St), the Everett Police had received a call for an intoxicated man at this location. Everett Police responded, but could not find the subject and cleared the area.

stateme	nt, At 1609 hours, they had been sit	ting on the front steps of 134 Linden St They	y observed
a Hispai	nic male, later identified as Mejia-M	lartinez, walk into the driveway of the apartme	ent
ouilding	addressed him, but he did	l not respond. Mejia-Martinez took his backp	ack off and
was mu	mbling to himself. did not t	think he was speaking Spanish and believed h	is
numbli	ng to be gibberish. Mejia-Martinez	sat on a small retaining wall in the driveway a	and began
hrowin	g trash out of the bag and on to the l	awn. yelled to him to "get the fuck o	utta here!"
Mejia-N	lartinez took out a pint of liquor, ch	ugged the bottle and smashed the glass bottle	in the
niddle	of Linden St as he walked away. (D	et. Lavey inspected the trash and observed it t	to be a
ottle o	f vodka). Mejia-Martinez looked ba	ack at and a few times like I	ne wanted
to fight.	Mejıa-Martinez walked across Lin-	den Street and on to Church St towards Broad	lway
Mejia-N	Martinez walked on to the porch of the	he first home on the right and spoke with a Pro	eacher's
wife bri	efly, but continued down Church St.		

3	Trooper Cashman and Det Bobby Hall arrived and spoke with the Preacher's wife
Trooper	Cashman showed photographs of Mejia-Martinez that he obtained from his brother
	confirmed that Mejia-Martinez had been the intoxicated man in his driveway during this
incident
